

GRIMES COUNTY ROAD & BRIDGE REPORT – 02/07/2024 Commissioners Court:

Grimes County received a significant amount of rainfall over the course of a few days. Some areas received up to 13 inches. Crews have been assessing and repairing damaged roads.

Removed downed trees from CR 207, 222, 315, 323 and 324.

Spread base on CR 180, 211, 212, 214, 216, 217, 219, 220, 222, 236, 277, 305, 306, 351, 405, 412, 445, 447, Pearl Lane and Red Oak.

Patched potholes with asphalt on portions of CR 304, 317, 318, 319, 420, 450, 451, Carter, Clark, Hill Street, John Rice, King Oaks, Lonestar, Rolling Oaks and Thane Lane.

Boom mowed CR 145, 168 and 201.

Cleaned brush and weeds around signs and guardrails on various roads.

Hauled culverts to CR 109, 122 and 137 for installation.

Lease trucks have been hauling base to FM 2445 Yard and Iola Yard.
