



DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of Grimes starting on the 25th of October 2025 and the days following has suffered widespread severe damage, loss of property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from severe weather and tornadic activity.

WHEREAS, the County Judge, Joe Fauth, of Grimes County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF GRIMES COUNTY

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Grimes County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners' Court of Grimes County.
3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Grimes County Clerk.
4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Grimes County emergency management plan.

That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
